Dear Families,

Welcome back to a new school year at St Joseph's. A warm welcome to all the new families who have joined us this term, in Foundation and other classes across the school. It has been wonderful to see the children looking so smart and full of smiles as they settle into their new classes.

The start of the year is always a good time to share a reminder about some of our key information, which I have included below:

<u>Homework</u>

All homework for Year 1 to Year 6 will be set on Mondays, to be completed by the following Monday. Completed homework should be uploaded on to Class Dojo. If you would like a paper copy of the homework, please speak to your child's class teacher. Curriculum Overviews will be emailed to all families on Friday 8th September. These overviews will include information about your child's homework project for this term. We can't wait to the children's creative ideas again this year.

<u>Uniform</u>

The children have returned to school looking extremely smart, wearing their school jumpers, cardigans and black shoes. Please remember that all children, apart from Foundation must wear a tie to school. Children with long hair should ensure that their hair is tied back. Watches can be worn to school, but they should not have alarms set or be linked to a phone. Small stud earrings can be worn to school, but these must be removed on PE days. Finally, PE kits should be in school every day so that children can have access to them, should they need them. If a PE kit is brought home, please bring it back to school the following day.

Foundation, Year 1 and Year 2 will finish the day at **3:10pm** and Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 at **3:15pm. Thank you.**
