Thank you for working with us to ensure that your children are in school and on time every day. This truly is a joint award between parents, children and school. Well done!

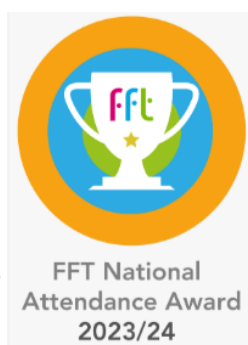
**This week's top class attendance:**
