Mr Liddle arrived home safely this week. Their remarkable journey ended with a visit to the wonderful school that will benefit from the funds raised. Thanks to their efforts, and your

wonderful support, a further 150 girls will have the opportunity to pursue education, breaking free from the cycles of early marriage and poverty. A further four classrooms will be built in a new block; work is planned to start very soon and these rooms will be dedicated to Matthew Liddle, an incredibly special legacy.

The school is now in its 28th year and has already supported 3500 girls. In addition to their education, they receive three meals a day, clothing and their families also benefit from financial support where they can. Mr Liddle and the team were overwhelmed by everything they saw; affirming their wish to give these girls the opportunity to be the best they can be. They thank you all, they could not have done this without your support.
