This fund was initially created to specifically support young people in any of our schools who may miss the opportunity to access a religious retreat or pilgrimage because of a lack of funds. Over the last few years, the fund has supported many students in this way, enabling children to go on pilgrimage to Lourdes and on retreat to places like Alton Castle, Soli House, the Briars and many other places. The fund has also been used, in exceptional cases, to support children and families who face other situations of hardship and supported with access to other opportunities which have enriched the lives of some of our young people.
