Trading Cards - Our School Rules Let's make trading fun, fair, and friendly for everyone!

Shake to Trade: A trade is only complete when both children shake hands. You can change your mind until the handshake. After that, the trade is final.

a Look After Your Cards: Children are responsible for their own cards. Cards may get lost or damaged – take care of your cards and respect others.

達 Find a Card? Hand it In! Give the found card to an adult. Don't keep or trade.

Keep Cards in Bags: Cards should only come out in the playground.

Playground Only! Cards must only be used in the playground (except during wet play). They will be taken away if used anywhere else.

Be Kind and Fair: No tricking, forcing, or pressuring others to trade. If someone says "no," that must be respected.

Cards for Cards Only: No trading cards for toys, money, or anything else.

Be Respectful: Always ask before touching or looking at someone else's cards.

Speak Up Tell an adult if someone is not following the rules.

Let's work together to make card trading a positive experience for everyone!
